But.....We have have supporters of our vision right across the UK which isn't bad for a grassroots community charity.




We exist to make meaningful connections with people in the community in order to empower, enable, involve and build up individuals and families, in doing so, demonstrating our Christian faith and God's love

He chose to continue to volunteer in our kitchen with Kirsty and is the inspiration to our new project "Discover yourself through cooking" which combines mentoring and cooking to support young people who have additional needs or find main stream education difficult.

Over the last 12 months we have worked with FareShare, West Midlands to reduce the amount of food wastage each year in the UK.

This has enabled the charity to provide affordable community meals, reduced our food costs in our play provision and even more than this we are able to share food with local families and individuals with our give aways.

We became acutely aware coming out of the pandemic, that we were entering into a new crisis and we needed to respond to support our families and children.


The Cost of living crisis has effected us all, and although the Government has put in place some support through the HAF program for families where children received free school meals, there was a lot of working parents who could not access this support. So we secured a pot of funding from Awards for All (National Lottery) which has enable us to offer our new Activity Weeks for children offering the core hours 10am-4pm for only £7.20 per day which we know has been really appreciated by our families. We continue to offer bolt on hours from 8am-10am and 4pm -6pm for parents who still need the extended day
